**DIESEL TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTOR (part-time)**

Wenatchee campus. This is a part-time position requiring teaching and coordination. Classes for 2017-18 academic year will be held in the evening. This position is scheduled to begin fall quarter 2017.

**GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The purpose of this position is to teach diesel technology courses, focusing on education, training and outreach. Position will teach courses related to diesel technology and assess student learning.

**SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES (including but not limited to):**

- Provide exceptional teaching of diesel technology courses and other classes as needed.
- Provide oversight of diesel technology students.
- Provide a leadership role in community outreach related to diesel technology across the college district.
- Incorporate inclusive and effective teaching methods/styles that support successful learning appropriate to a diverse student population.
- Collaborate collegially in the review and improvement of departmental processes, course materials, teaching methodologies, and assessment methods in order to dynamically meet the needs of the students, college and community.
- Develop and maintain healthy and positive working relationships with students, staff, faculty and administration.
- Engage in scholarly and continuous improvement activities that complement and inform teaching.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Five years of full-time experience in a diesel technology related occupation or a two year certificate in a closely related field with four years of experience;
- Ability to use the Internet, word processing, email, presentation, spreadsheet and other related software applications;
- Strong positive interpersonal skills;
- Strong oral and written communication skills;
- Ability to work with diverse populations;
- Ability to work independently and on a flexible schedule;
- Valid driver's license.
- Requires ability to work during the hours of 6-9 pm. Work schedule will be 8 hours a week or less.
- New instructors must complete industrial first aid/CPR and maintain vocational certification as required by the Washington State Law and Wenatchee Valley College rules.

**DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Associate degree or higher in diesel technology, automotive or closely related field.
- More than five years of diesel technology related industry experience.
- Teaching or training experience (preferably in a community and/or technical college setting).
- ASE Certified.
- Experience using CANVAS or other online course management technology.
- Supervisory experience.
